MOST STAINS ON SOLUTION-DYED FABRICS CAN BE CLEANED UP WITH A MILD SOAP AND WATER SOLUTION. Solution-Dyed fabrics should be cleaned regularly before substances such as dirt, etc., are allowed to accumulate on and become embedded in the fabric. The fabric can be cleaned without being removed from the umbrella. Simply brush off any loose dirt, etc., clean with warm water (no more than 100° F) and a mild natural soap. Rinse thoroughly to remove soap. When using liquid detergent, it may be necessary to re-apply a water repellent treatment, such as our **Upholstery & Fabric Protector (TGC-UFP-32)**. When washing or cleaning, **DO NOT SUBJECT TO EXCESSIVE HEAT** as the fabric will shrink. **DO NOT STEAM PRESS OR DRY IN ELECTRIC OR GAS DRYERS.** Allow fabric to air dry. In case Solution-Dyed fabrics are stored during the winter season, it should be cleaned, allowed to air dry and stored in a dry, well ventilated area. For stubborn stains, please see the stain cleaning chart for more specific cleaning instructions.

BEER	• liquid detergent, white vinegar	MILDEW	• 1/2 cup of bleach and 1/4 cup natural soap per gallon of water
BERRY	• liquid detergent/ammonia (3-6% water)	MILK	• liquid detergent
BLOOD (dried)	• detergent/ammonia (3-6% water)	NAIL POLISH	• volatile solvent (acetone)
BUTTER	• volatile solvent (acetone)	OIL	• volatile solvent (acetone)
CHARCOAL, PENCIL MARKS	• vacuum, then liquid detergent	ORANGE DRINK	• liquid detergent, water
CATSUP OR MUSTARD	• liquid detergent	PAINT (latex) WET	• liquid detergent, water
CHEWING GUM	• volatile solvent (acetone)	PAINT (latex) DRIED	• paint, oil or grease remover
CHOCOLATE	• liquid detergent, ammonia water	PAINT (oil or lacquer)	• paint, oil or grease remover
COFFEE	• detergent, white vinegar volatile solvent (acetone)	SHOE POLISH (liquid)	• volatile solvent (acetone)
COLA	• liquid detergent	SHOE POLISH (wax)	• apply heated iron over towel, volatile solvent (acetone)
CRAYON	• paint, oil or grease remover	SUNTAN LOTION	• Pine Power or pine oil detergent
EGG (raw)	• liquid detergent	TEA	• liquid detergent
GRAPE JUICE	• liquid detergent (water)	TOMATO JUICE	• liquid detergent
GRAVY	• liquid detergent	TREE SAP	• turpentine, liquid detergent
GREASE	• volatile solvent (acetone)	URINE	• liquid detergent, white vinegar
INK	• paint remover, volatile solvent (acetone), detergent	VOMIT	• detergent, water, white vinegar
IRON RUST	• oxalic or citrus acids, water	WATER COLOR	• liquid detergent, water, white vinegar
LIPSTICK	• paint, oil or grease remover	WAX (candle)	• apply heated iron over towel, volatile solvent (acetone)
MASCARA	• paint remover, volatile solvent (acetone), detergent	WINE	• liquid detergent/ammonia (3-6% water), white vinegar

Limited warranty: 1 year against fading and free of manufacturer's defects (stitching, elastics, velcro)

RhinoWeave fabric should be cleaned periodically with mild soap and water & scrub with soft brush. After cleaning, always rinse thoroughly with clean water and allow to air dry. **DO NOT USE BLEACH.**
